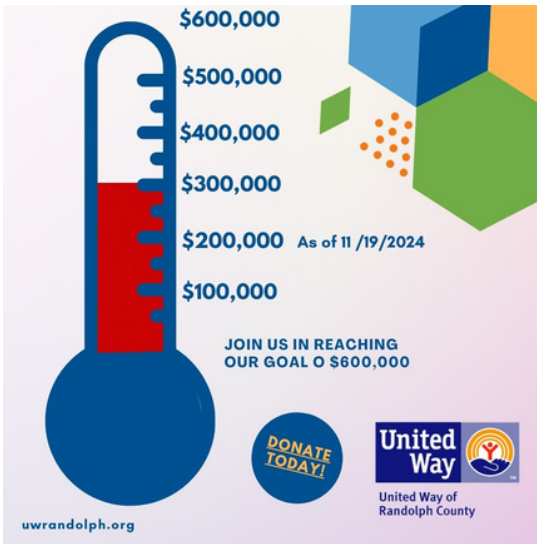

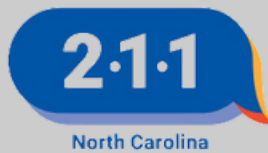
Thanksgiving Holiday Office Closure
