(Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed)

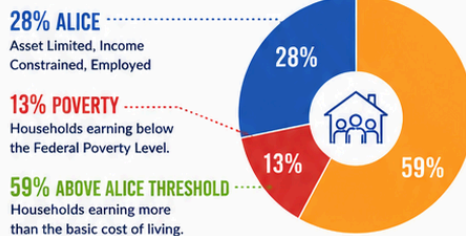
